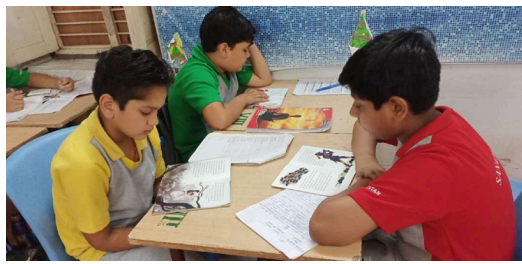
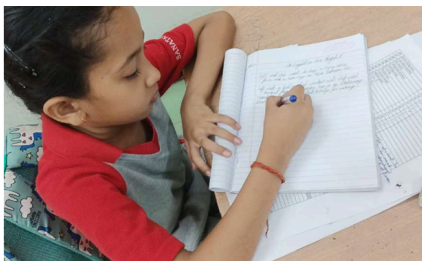


SUMMER CAMP

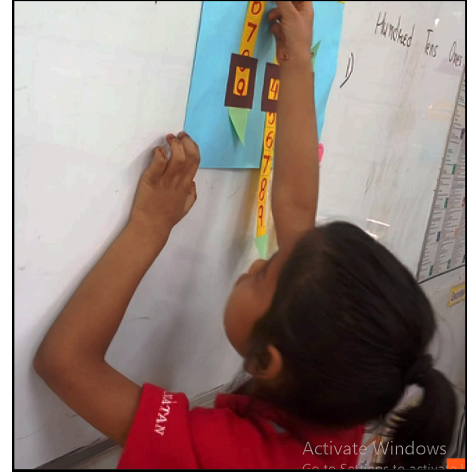
PEEP INTO CLASSROOMS

By involving students in practical tasks, these activities enhance understanding, critical thinking, and retention of knowledge. Introduction to maps
